1. Diagram the following sentences:

1. <sup>I</sup> [Columbus' ship had lain (at anchor)] [<sup>II</sup> where Janet gazed.]

*This is a complex declarative sentence.*

*I is a principal clause.*

*II is subordinate adverbial clause of place, introduced by the subordinate conjunction "where," modifying "had lain."*

*a is an adverbial prepositional phrase of place, modifying the verb "had lain."*

2. <sup>I</sup> [Edgar Allen Poe may have sat] [<sup>II</sup> where I now was sitting.]

*This is a complex declarative sentence.*

*I is a principal clause.*

*II is subordinate adverbial clause of place, introduced by the subordinate conjunction "where," modifying "may have sat."*

3. <sup>I</sup> [I walked] [<sup>II</sup> where I could see the Mississippi State Capitol.] <sup>DO</sup>

*This is a complex declarative sentence.*

*I is a principal clause.*

*II is subordinate adverbial clause of place, introduced by the subordinate conjunction "where," modifying "walked."*
